To scale the program, Company partnered with a new NGO in the region of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka to test the success of the program and hence initial pilot months saw lesser volume uptake. In the F.Y. 2023-24, Company intends to utilize the un-spent CSR amount for the F.Y. 2021-22, completely.
