Advancing Sustainable Agriculture

- From 2016-2018, Kellogg enabled 329,000 farmers, many of whom are women and smallholders, through initiatives to implement more sustainable farming practices using climate-smart agriculture and reduce post-harvest loss.
- To ensure we are responsibly sourcing our priority ingredients, we actively engage suppliers and farmers in our direct supply chain.



Conserving Natural Resources

- By the end of 2025, we are committed to:
 - 100% reusable, recyclable, or compostable packaging
 - Continuing to ensure 100% of all timber-based packaging is recycled or certified as sustainably sourced
- By the end of 2030, we are committed to:
 - 30% reduction in water use in facilities in high water stress regions.
 - 50% reduction in organic waste, including food waste across our facilities.
 - 45% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.
 - 15% reduction in Scope 3 GHG emissions.
- By 2050, we are committed to:
 - 100% electricity from renewable sources
 - 65% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 emissions
 - 50% reduction in Scope 3 emissions by partnering with direct suppliers
